Make sure you are putting different materials into the correct bins. Is it the blue bin or the black bin?</p>	<p>Bees are really important for our environment. Why not plant some flower seeds. Talk about size, shape and colour as you watch them grow. You could send us some pictures via Facebook.</p>	<p>When getting your daily exercise, record what coloured bees/insects you see. How many colours did you find? Which colour did you see the most?</p>	<p>With your recycling, get a plastic bottle and pop it in your garden. See how much rain you can collect throughout the week and record how much there is each week.</p> 
<p>Look out for some flowers in your garden out when out on a walk. Maybe you could water the flowers to help them grow? Take a watering can or bottle with you.</p>	<p>When outdoors, why not take a pair of scissors (with adult supervision and permission) to cut the edges of the grass. You could then put the grass cuttings into the compost heap.</p>	<p>Plan a route for your daily walk. Take a bag with you to collect litter. Wear protective gloves if you have any and remember to wash your hands!</p>	<p>Recycle your milk bottles. Add stones to the bottles to make weights. Start by lifting the weights 10 times on Monday and see what number you get to by the end of the week!</p>	<p>Why not take part in an outdoor scavenger hunt? Take the list attached and see what you can find. Maybe you could use some of the items you find to make a birds nest?</p>
<p>Make a 'bee bath' for your garden or an outdoor windowsill. Use water with a small amount of sugar or decorate with flowers and stones.</p> 	<p>You could recycle and decorate an old shoe box or cardboard box and make a bird house. Visit <a href="http://www.parentcircle.com">www.parentcircle.com</a> for eco-friendly activities.</p>	<p>Go on a nature walk and identify inhabitants of the wild. Discuss what would happen if their natural habitats were destroyed. You could brainstorm ideas about how we can help protect the land and environment around us.</p>	<p>You could recycle some egg boxes to make and decorate a boat to play with.</p> 	<p>Recycle old cereal boxes and make a lovely picture frame for some of your beautiful art work. You could hang these up and send us some of your pictures!</p>

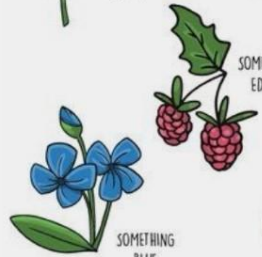
