- Animals that live in the Twilight Zone often have big eyes to help them see.

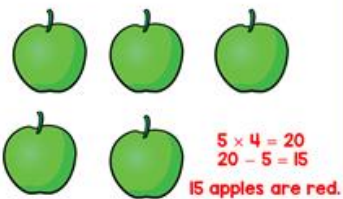
