Literacy

In Reading we will be learning to:

- Recognise an increasing number of common words
- Use our knowledge of phonics to sound out less familiar words
- Identify what has happened at the beginning, middle and end of a story

In Writing we will be learning to:

- Make our sentences more interesting by using different sentence starters
- Remember to use a capital and a full stop in each sentences
- Extend our sentences by using simple connectives such as 'and' or 'because'

In Listening and Talking we will be learning to:

- Be a good listener by looking at the person who is talking
- Take part in class/group discussions and share ideas

How you can help at home

Literacy

- -Look for weekly common words in the environment and in books at home.
- -Continue to hear your child read and discuss the text with who, what, where, why, when and how questions.

Numeracy/Maths

- -Count on from any given number
- -Count back from any given number
- -Practise adding two numbers together using fingers
- -Look at clocks at home and in the environment and try to identify when it is O'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to.
- -Share your timeline with your child:
 - When you were born
 - When you were a toddler
 - When you started primary school
 - When you started high school
 - When you started your first job
 - When you started your current job

Numeracy and Maths

In Numeracy we will be learning to:

- Count on and back from a give number
- Use a range of concrete materials to illustrate addition and subtractions calculations
- Record calculations using the standard, written method, e.g. 12+6=18
- Show understanding of maths symbols when writing sums,
 e.g. + =

<u>In Maths we will be learning:</u>

- To identify when it is quarter to or quarter past on an analogue clock
- How many minutes are in an hour
- How many seconds are in a minute
- Compare/match digital and analogue times
- Read and write the date
- To understand the 'bigger picture' of time through our 1970s topic.
