	 Welcome to Week 4 of Home Learning ^(C) This week we are leaving the 'Heart of Scotland' and flying back in time and further South to learn about the "Ancient Greeks". Our Big question we aim to answer this week is "What is a Community?" We will begin to investigate when the Ancient Greeks ruled, who the Ancient Greeks were and what life was like within their community. In maths, we will continue to challenge our understanding of place value. For our literacy, we will be delving into a new book: Kid Normal by Greg James & Chris Smith. We will use chapters of this book to investigate themes and to visualise our thoughts on the main character. Kid Normal will also inspire some creative writing.
