Hello, P6! I have made a few changes to the learning grid, so please take the time to read this information if you are not familiar with the new process. It contains sixteen tasks and you can plan to do these at times that are most convenient for you over the course of the week. All essential resources have been made available to you on Teams, so each activity will direct you to the appropriate materials. They have been clearly organised into the correct subject areas; numeracy and literacy. Simply click on the 'files' tab at the top, select home learning then **WC 1**st **March 2021** to access these. You have now also been provided with individual copies of the task instructions for each lesson, instead of masters. These are located in your own folders. **These working documents will be used to upload all completed learning. They should be edited to record answers and add images, eliminating the need to download texts or upload photos to different folders. These can be found on One Note under the heading 'WC 1ST March 2021.' It is important for you to understand that not all activities require work to be submitted. Those that do are highlighted in green on the grid.**

I know that you will all be trying your very best at home, so it is important that you get quality feedback for the tasks that you complete. As you are submitting work to your individual folders, this will be provided on a separate document in One Note. Any advice to be given to the whole class will be shared on our live discussions.


