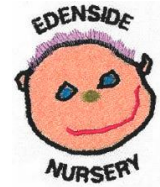




Edenside Primary School and Nursery

Routines

Ensuring a safe place to learn is the most important priority right now. We are returning to school under 'Level 4' restrictions, meaning we need rigorous and robust mitigations in place. These include 'class bubbles', playground zones, staggered breaks and lunchtimes, regularly hand sanitising, face masks for staff and drop-off/pick-up arrangements.
