

Learning Grids

Hello, P6! I have made a few changes to the learning grid, so please take the time to read this information if you are not familiar with the new process. It contains sixteen tasks and you can plan to do these at times that are most convenient for you over the course of the week. All essential resources have been made available to you on Teams, so each activity will direct you to the appropriate materials. They have been clearly organised into the correct subject areas; numeracy and spelling. Simply click on the 'files' tab at the top, select home learning then **WC 8th March 2021** to access these. You have now also been provided with individual copies of the task instructions for each lesson, instead of masters. These are located in your own folders. **These working documents will be used to upload all completed learning. They should be edited to record answers and add images, eliminating the need to download texts or upload photos to different folders. These can be found on One Note under the heading WC 8th March 2021.** It is important for you to understand that not all activities require work to be submitted. Those that do are highlighted in green on the grid.

Feedback

I know that you will all be trying your very best at home, so it is important that you get quality feedback for the tasks that you complete. As you are submitting work to your individual folders, this will be provided by email. Any advice to be given to the whole class will be shared on our live discussions.

Firstly, we have a class Facebook page which your parents or carers can access to contact me. We will also be using our class Teams 'general' channel each day. Please be assured that you do not have to participate in all of these, but you are expected to join the morning sessions.

Reading Wise (Reading)

Learning Intention: I am learning to develop my decoding and comprehension skills



Every time you read a book, magazine or comic, you use decoding and comprehension skills. **Decoding** is the ability to apply your knowledge of sounds and letter patterns to correctly pronounce written words. **Comprehension** refers to how you construct meaning and retrieve information from a text. It is important for you to be able to apply both.

Task:

- Login to your Reading Wise account and spend one hour working through your decoding or comprehension programme

This could be done in one sitting or could be spread out over the course of the week.

Column Subtraction (Numeracy)

Learning Intention: I am learning to subtract two-digit numbers using column subtraction
