Literacy

Reading

Reading this term will begin with our modelling block where we are reading The Breadwinner by Deborah Ellis. Our story is set around a family in Afghanistan and explores life under Taliban law. We will be using and developing our six reading strategies to support discussions about the themes and main ideas within our book. As the theme is very topical we are able to have some meaningful class discussions. At the end of term we will be looking at fiction books and continuing to use our six strategies to support us. We will be taking part in reading daily in class with books chosen from our class library.

Writing

In writing we are developing our story telling skills through narrative writing. After our narrative sessions are complete we will be turning our attention to recount writing - looking at the various way to do this.

Spelling and Grammar

In spelling we will be going over common words and making sure we are feeling confident with them. We will be strengthening our spelling strategies to help us spell out unfamiliar words.

Mr Fairnington will be leading grammar this term and will be looking at word contractions, capital letters and VCOP - vocabulary, connectives, openers and punctuation.

Curriculum Overview

August - October 2021

Topic

This term we are looking into Scotland's history with the fight for freedom. We will begin our topic discussing what freedom means, moving into the 1200s and the wars for independence that occurred. We will then research the Jacobites and finish the term looking at the modern day fights for independence in the form of the Referendum. Hopefully our topic allows us to have many interesting conversations and discussions at school and at home.

We will be looking to refine the physical techniques involved in each game, and enhance our understanding of the tactics involved to be successful. We are really emphasising on developing our personal qualities when competing; by playing fairly, respecting opponents, and what it means to be a good teammate.

Health and Wellbeing

Primary 6/7 will be using Skipper this term to aid our learning throughout health and wellbeing. We will be having discussions on resilience, inclusion and diversity to ensure our class is a welcoming and respectful environment for all.

We will be revisiting our Edenside Learners which for P6/7 is now the Kingdoms of Learning - our kingdoms are:

As we journey through each kingdom we will be discussing how they can motivate us to do our best and aim high.
