Literacy

It continues to be important for you to hear your child read. If they struggle when reading a word, they can use these word attack strategies.

- Look at the first letter.
- Sound out the first few letters.
- Look at the last letters.
- Look at the shape of the word.
- Read the sentence again.
- Look for a rhyme.
- Break the word into syllables.

Maths

This term's non-number maths focus is time. When you are out and about, you can help your child to find places showing o'clock, half past, quarter to, and quarter past times, for example:

- house clocks
- digital displays (TVs, microwaves, ovens, phones)
- watches/fit bits
- town hall/shops
- car dashboard
- many more!

Encourage your child to know when certain events happen. They could tell you what time they go to school, go swimming, when their favourite TV programme is on etc
