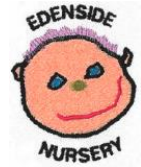

We have had the high limb of the willow tree, that looked in danger of falling, removed by an SBC contractor this week. They discovered there are further limbs which require further investigation and possible removal.

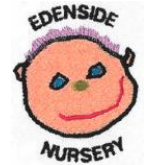
The area remains blocked off and out of bounds until they have completed their investigations.
