Access to Bikes Scheme for P1-5

Please get in touch if you are interested in a fully funded loan of a bike for your child. The criteria are as follows – Your child:

- Does not currently have access to a bike for financial reasons.
- Would benefit from access to a bike i.e. would actually use it regularly (some kids just aren't interested!).
- Can already cycle or is committed to learning to cycle.
- Is able to store the bike securely.

This is a long term loan scheme, where they would expect the bike back when a child outgrows it, and we would then service it and loan it to another child. Parent / Carers must sign a basic contract.
