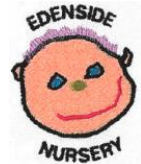

### Singing in the Square

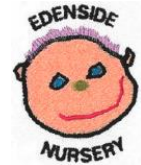
We enjoyed singing in the square this week. Thank you to everyone who came along!
