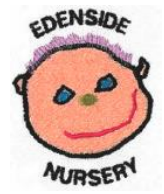

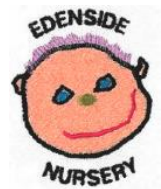

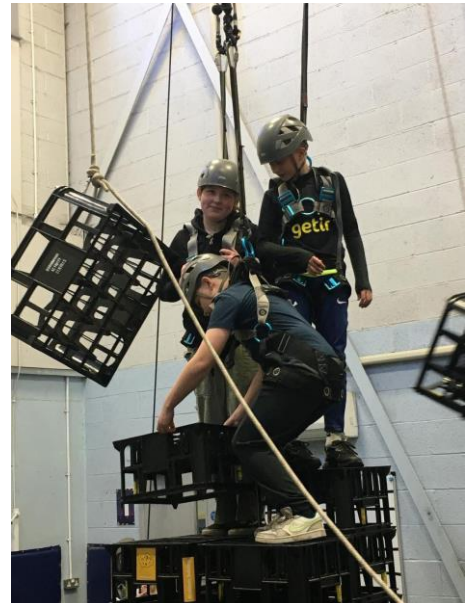

Look out for an email next week containing information out about the residential, due to take place September 2026, at the beginning of their P7 year.



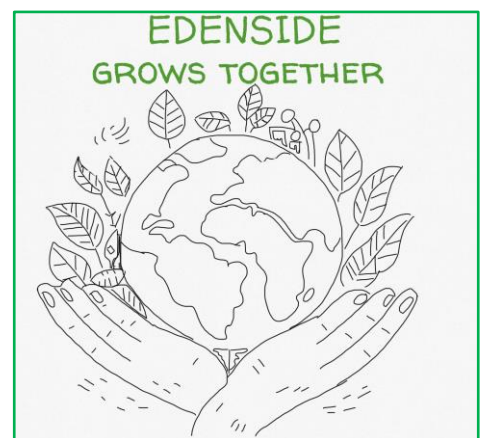
Edenside Grows Together
