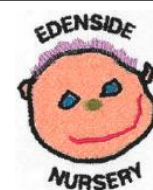

### Staffing news

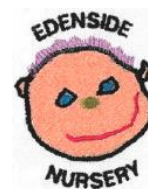

We came second in the poster competition too!

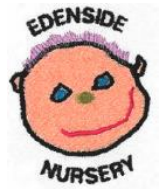
