- Swimming will take place this term for our class- please check the bulletin and calendar for details.

Daily mile

- Most days will see the class clocking up the miles running/walking around for 15-20min each afternoon.



What We're Learning

- Numeracy: We're working on place value and recognising how to read, write and order numbers.
- Reading: We're reading 'The Good Turn' and focusing on locating evidence, looking at interesting vocabulary and working on our inference skills. Pupils will also read regularly in class for enjoyment and study addition reading comprehension texts.
- In writing we will be revisiting previous learning, looking at sentence structure and then moving onto paragraph structure.
- In spelling we will look at high frequency words, phonics. Key topic related vocabulary will be used throughout the term.
- Our topic will be on Antarctica but with a science focus on changing states. The children will learn how to set up a fair test and how to make a hypothesis.

Home calendar and Homework

- P6 and P7 can be a very busy with lots of activities and events taking place throughout the year. We have adopted the use of a calendar to help keep us organised. Parents should sign each day to indicate that they've seen it. Please feel free to use this for written communication with myself.
- Throughout the year your child will get homework. Some will read their group novels at home (Starting in term 2). In addition, we will also be sending home mental maths homework on a weekly basis. We may occasionally ask your child to complete a topic task at home.
