- **Numeracy:** We are learning to use mental strategies and formal methods for addition and subtraction. We will look at multiplication and division later in the term.
- **Reading:** We have now split into our novel groups. We will all be exploring our texts by applying various reading strategies such as inference and summarisation.
- **Writing:** we will be look at more complex sentence structures and how to apply these to our own writing. We will continue to look at editing our own work.
- **Spelling:** we will be learning about prefixes and suffixes and how to use these to generate new words.
