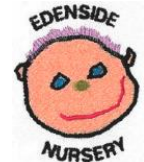

### Reminders

P6s and P7s : Come to school wearing PE kit on Monday please. Please have an extra warm layer as well as a snack and water bottle, for the Cross-Country Competition (Kelso).

Please do not send snacks or packed lunches with nuts in them. Lollipops and sweeties are not ok for snacks and packed lunches.

**Please make sure you child has a (named) water bottle in school.** Please can these be refreshed daily, at home. We do have water fountains for refills (or the occasional forgotten bottle), but it takes time away from learning if a lot of people need to use these. Children can drink water throughout the day. Flavoured water or juice in water bottles is not permitted. Children are not allowed to drink the juice / soft drink provided with a home packed lunch during break time, unless this is part of a medical plan in place which has been agreed with the school nurse. These expectations are to ensure we are keeping within the Scottish Government guidance.
