Topic this term:

This term, our topic is the Victorians. The children will be learning about life during Queen Victoria's reign (1837–1901) and how it compares to life today. We will explore Victorian homes, schools, inventions, and daily life, as well as some important figures from the period. It's an exciting topic that will help bring history to life through a range of engaging activities.

What We're Learning

- **Numeracy:** This term we will be focused on learning about Time, Money and Fractions.
- **Reading:** We have again split into our novel groups. We will all be exploring our texts by applying various reading strategies such as inference and summarisation.
- **Writing:** we will be looking at Narrative texts. In particular we will learn how to plan and structure a story, how to use direct speech and how to use figurative language to help our stories come alive!
- **Spelling:** we will be learning about prefixes and suffixes and how to use these to generate new words.
