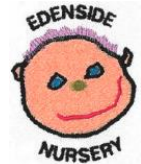

A big SHOUT OUT to the volunteer helpers from KHS, Chris Fraser (active Schools) as well as Mr Sutton our brilliant PE teacher.

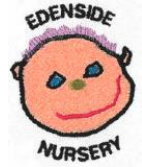
