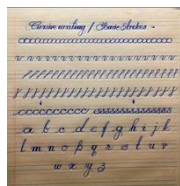


P5 Summer to October Curricular Overview 2026

Health and Wellbeing:

- We will be making a class charter together.
- We will be learning how 'effort' and 'struggle' sit alongside 'learning', 'laughter' and 'love' in our learning journey together this year.
- Regular 2 hours a week of PE continue.

Math:

- Time, including 12/24hr and weeks/ months of the year.
- Data gathering and representation.
- Measure in length, area and volume.

IDL/ Topic based learning:

- We start by investigating life around us through insects and the rearing of ladybirds in class.
- We will progress to learn about endemic wildlife in Madagascar.
- The children will also learn about- oceans/ continents/ basic geology and the cultural differences between here and Madagascar.
- Children will share their learning at the 'World Sharing Day' on October 1st 2:15-3:15pm.

Reading:

- Starting off with a class novel (Charlie and the Chocolate Factory).
- Moving on to group texts.
- Pupils will read independently every morning.
- Some pupils will have access to Barrington Stokes books.
- We will also engage with reading comprehension texts and non-fiction texts.

Number:

- A big focus on place value and the use of place value in moving between units of measure. Up to 100,000 and down to 10th.
- Estimating and rounding.
- Multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100 using knowledge of place value.
- Addition and subtraction strategies.

Writing:

- We will review and revisit previous writing targets with the whole class. Within this we will cover key basic punctuation.
- Introduction to compound and complex sentences.
- Introduction to writing direct speech.
- Regular cursive handwriting practise lessons.
- Regular creative and expressive writing opportunities.
